Ensure that Head Start Performance Standards and MN Rule #3 licensing guidelines are followed in the classroom. Complete ongoing assessment and tracking of children's outcomes.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS: Preferred: Baccalaureate degree in Early Childhood Education (ECE) or advanced degree and coursework equivalent to a major relating to ECE. Minimum: Associate degree in Early Childhood Education or an associate degree in related field (with coursework equivalent to a major relating to ECE), or an associate's degree with a current preschool child development associate credential. Must be 18 years old or older and have experience teaching preschool age children.
