JOB SUMMARY: Work as part of a collaborative team to establish and maintain an age and developmentally appropriate Head Start / Early childhood classroom. Ensure that Head Start Performance Standards and MN Rule #3 licensing guidelines are followed in the classroom. Complete ongoing assessment and tracking of children's outcomes.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS: Preferred: Baccalaureate degree in Early Childhood Education or advanced degree and coursework equivalent to a major relating to early childhood education. Minimum: Associate degree in Early Childhood Education or an associate degree in related field with coursework equivalent to a major relating to early childhood education, or an associate's degree with a current preschool child development associate credential. Must be 18 years old or older and have experience teaching preschool age children.

RATE OF PAY: Entry wage of \$15.10 - \$16.72 per hour based on qualifications.

HOURS: 40 hours/week; 9 months/year following school calendar
