Qualifications:

- · Age 18 or older.
- Child Development Associate (CDA) credential from the Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition preferred. In lieu of CDA:
 - High school diploma or GED along with 12 quarter credits (or 8 semester credits) and 2,080 hours as a child care center aide or student intern; or
 - Various other combinations of education and experience according to Minnesota 9503.0033 Child Care Center Licensing requirements.
- Prefer 6 months' experience working in a child care setting.
- Able to obtain certification in infant/child CPR and First Aid within 3 months.
- Able to successfully complete training for sudden unexpected infant death (SUID) and abusive head trauma (AHT).
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Prefer bilingual skills in English/Spanish.
- Able to lift and/or carry 50 pounds from floor to shoulder height frequently.
- Able to reach above shoulder level; bend/stoop; squat; crawl; climb; kneel; balance; push/pull; sit on the floor; and move quickly in the event of an emergency. (Additional detail included with job description.)
